

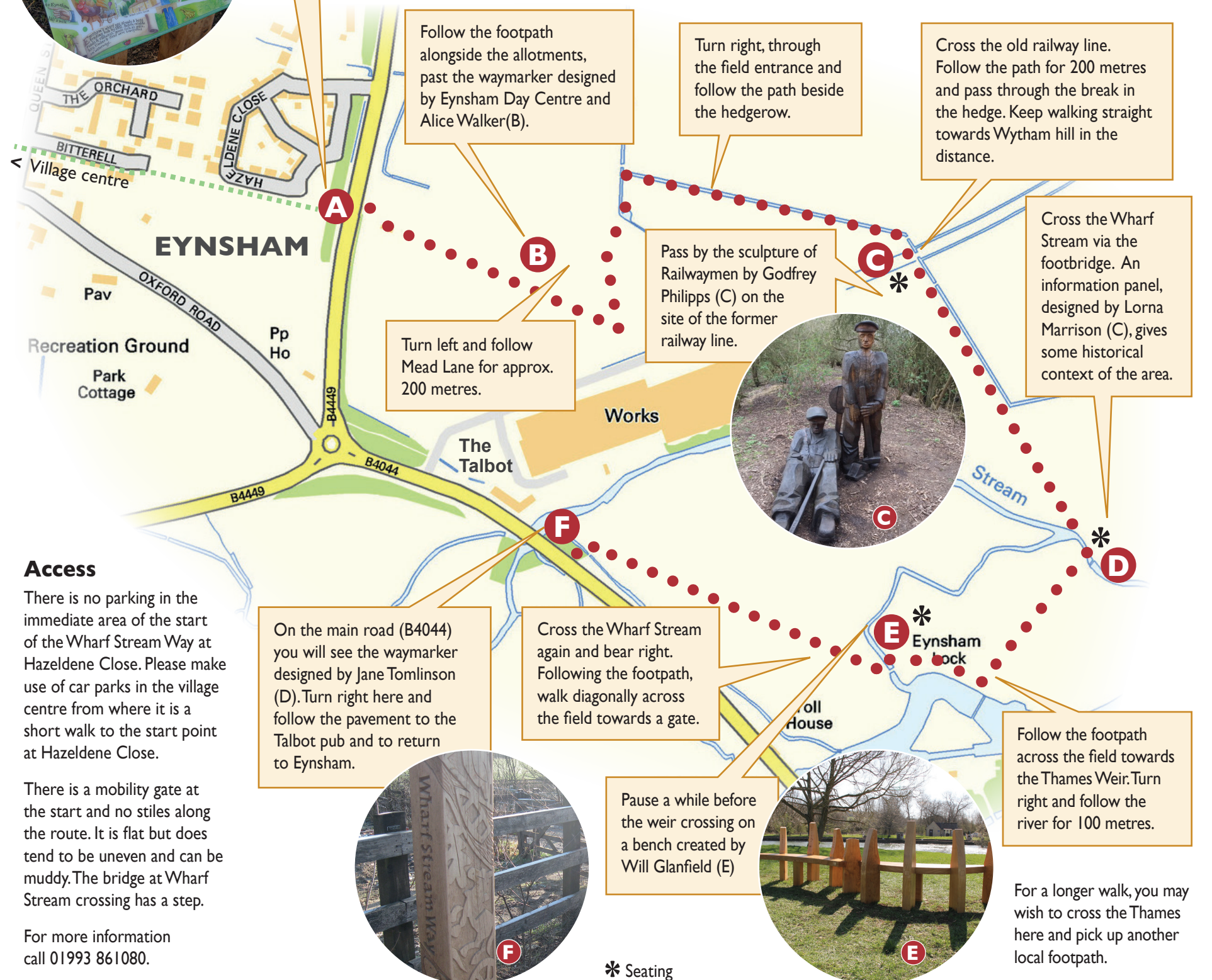


START at the edge of Hazeldene Close, by Jane Tomlinson's interpretation panel (A). Carefully cross the main road (B4449.)



Wharf Stream Way

A fascinating 2km/1.25 mile route with a rich history, which, apart from the Wharf Stream crossing, is largely invisible. Unique artworks, designed by local residents, have been used to bring the history of the route to life. Why not come and see for yourself....



Access

There is no parking in the immediate area of the start of the Wharf Stream Way at Hazeldene Close. Please make use of car parks in the village centre from where it is a short walk to the start point at Hazeldene Close.

There is a mobility gate at the start and no stiles along the route. It is flat but does tend to be uneven and can be muddy. The bridge at Wharf Stream crossing has a step.
