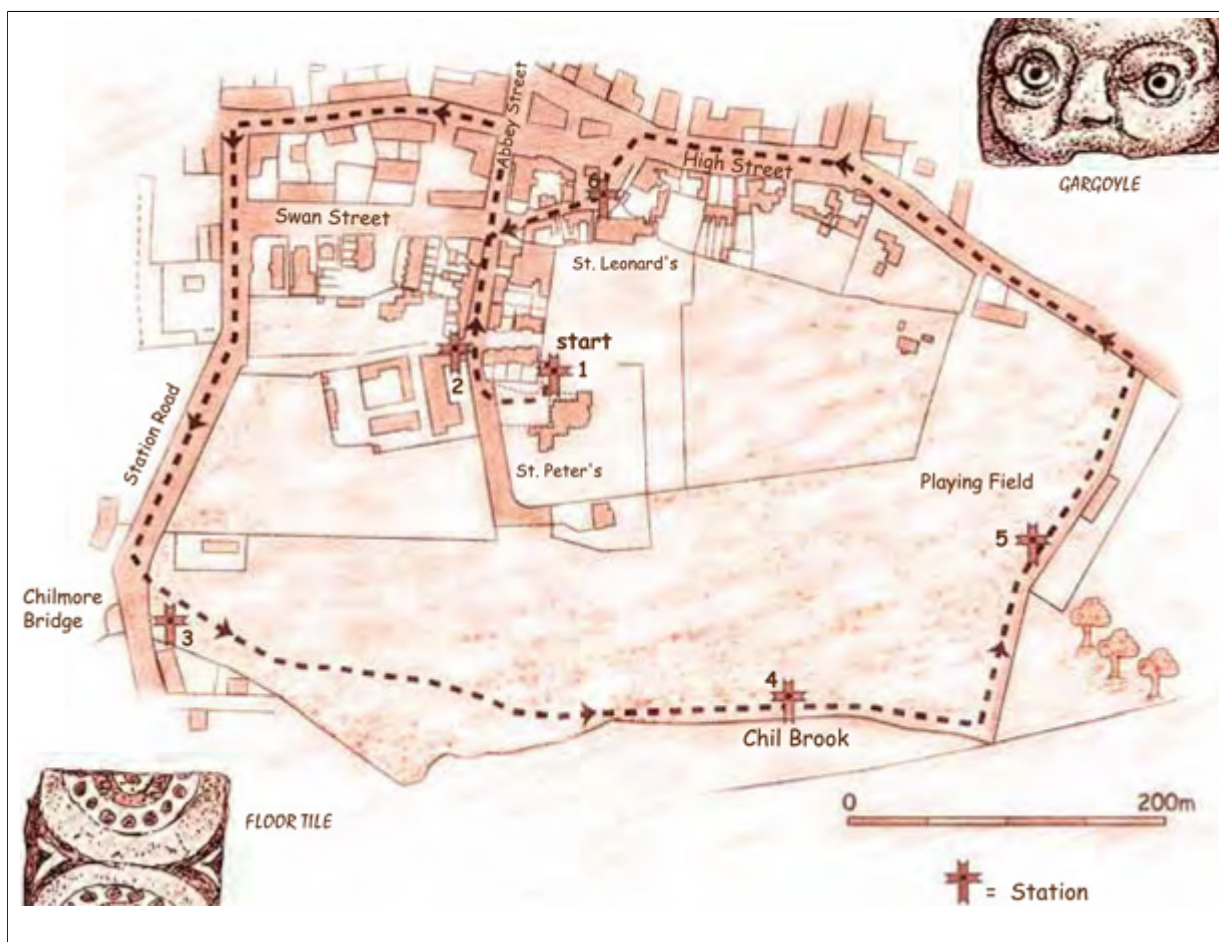


EYNSHAM ABBEY HERITAGE TRAIL

a walk into the past, around the precinct of Eynsham Abbey



▶ Although the first station you see may be the one in the market place, it is best to begin the tour in the car park of St Peters Church, in front of the main display **Station 1**.

▶ From there **Station 2** is 50m away, just outside the car park entrance in Abbey Street, beside the entrance to Abbey Farm.

▶ To follow the perimeter of the precinct, walk up Abbey Street to the corner of Acre End Street (by The Jolly Sportsman). Turn left, and continue until you come to Station Road on your left, by The Swan Inn. Walk down Station Road for about 300m until you see a small car park on your left, where you will find **Station 3**.

(A short cut can be taken by using Swan Street instead of Acre End Street.)

▶ From Station 3, follow the footpath through the abbey's fishponds area for about 250 m, until you come out into the playing fields. Keep on for another 100m to find **Station 4**, on your right.

▶ From Station 4 continue around the sports pitch for 200m to find **Station 5**.

▶ From Station 5 continue to the entrance to the playing field. Turn left and walk back into the village, about 400m, until you see the *market place* on your left. There you will find **Station 6**.
