Shrub bed planting areas to be prepared by cutting the grass short in the area for planting and spraying with herbicide to remove all grass and weeds. Areas to be cultivated and planted, incorporating compost into the soil to a depth of 300mm.

Plants to be planted in species groups as specified and beds to be mulched with 50mm deep layer of bark mulch.

Standard trees to be planted in 1 cubic metre pit. The base of the pits to be aerated and the substrate replaced around the root ball firming in layers and incorporating tree planting compost.

Tree to be staked and tied with a double short stake, cross bar and rubber tree-tie method. Base of the tree to be mulched with a 50mm layer of bark mulch.
