Wytham View Play Area

- Progress of the Project – the old equipment has been removed, fencing erected and work due to start on installation of the new equipment.
- The tree work urgently needs to be done. Mrs Beavis will identify the trees most urgently needed to be removed. **Action: Mrs Beavis**
- Howie Watkins, OCC requires the loge of all grant giving organisations.
- The COMMA monitoring report was agreed and signed. **Action: Clerk**
- Electrical supply to the Play Area – Southern Electric have now advised that OCC had advised incorrectly and that the supply can not be unmetered. They will now quote for the installation on this basis.
- The Wytham View Residents Working Group takes place 17 March 2010. Bill Butcher, Crime Reduction Officer will attend the meeting.
- Naming of the Play Area - It was agreed to name the play area Dovehouse Go and Play as suggested by Elly Podbery who will be invited to open the play area and given a £10 book token. (**Post Meeting Note:** It was agreed that Dovehouse Come and Play would be the name of the play area).

Events for the Official Opening – Suggestions were football, face painting, origami, Young peoples Morris Dancing. Give away balloons with “Dovehouse Go and Play” printed on them. The possibility of inviting a local celebrity, possibly from the local television, was considered.
