Progress of the Project –

- The tree work has been completed. Work on the equipment is continuing off-site and the roundabout base is now in place.
- The Aiming High monitoring report was agreed with opening times being during daylight hours.
- Electrical supply to the Play Area – Southern Electric have been reminded of the urgent need for the quote to provide an electrical supply.
- The Wytham View Residents Working Group took place 17 March 2010. It was a successful meeting attended by Bill Butcher, Crime Reduction Officer who discussed concerns over anti-social behaviour and how to deal with the problem should it arise. Cllr Beach will continue to press for a NAG specifically for the area.
