18/FP12 To receive apologies for absence – Cllr Gordon Beach, Cllr Peter Emery, Cllr Nick Relph and Cllr Mark Zumbuhl.

18/FP13 To receive Declarations of Interest in agenda items - None.

18/FP14 To review the meeting minutes of the 20 March 2018 – It was noted that the minutes were approved at Full Council meeting on 3 April 2018.

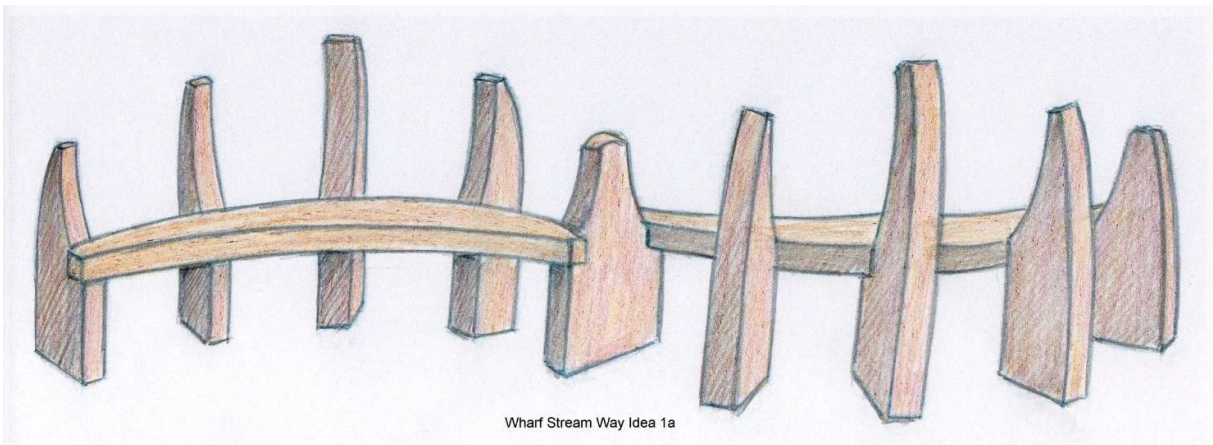
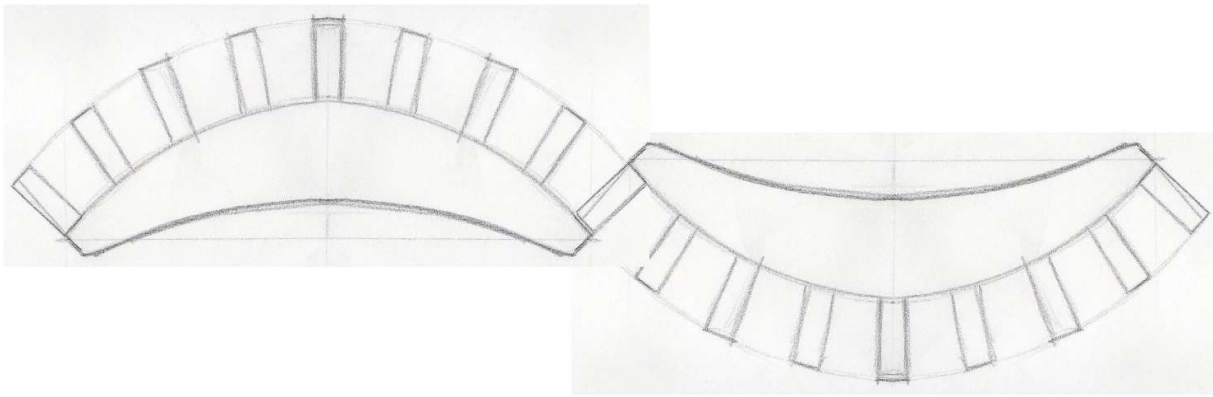
18/FP16 To welcome Will Glanfield and consider designs for further artwork at Wharf Stream Way – Will Glanfield was welcomed to the meeting. Will discussed 4 preliminary designs for the artwork, 3 of which had previously been circulated to members. Members **RECOMMENDED** that design 1 is approved which reflects the local environment, vessels and the way the water moves through the landscape. (See appendix A attached). The artwork will be made of jarra uprights and oak seats. It will be made in parts, constructed on site and set in concrete 50cm below ground level. The carved designs depicting the transported loads to the wharf and place names will be considered in the coming months. The Clerk is to draft a planning application when specifications are received from Will and submit to the District Council. Transportation of the artwork on the site was discussed – it was felt that a group of volunteers could help in this respect. Further consideration is to be given nearer the time of installation. It was agreed that the proposed design will be added to the website for residents’ information.

18/FP17 To review the timetable for the next stages of the projects and agree actions – The Clerk reviewed the timetable which is in accordance with the Agreement Schedule.

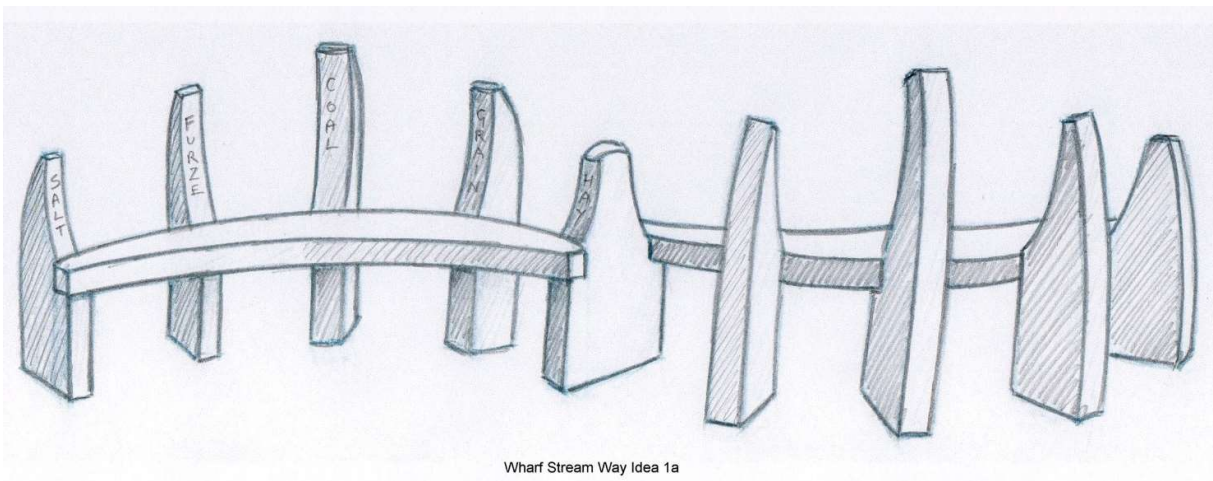

This design creates an S shape with each seat facing in opposite directions - offering views both to the Thames and inland towards Wharf Stream. The buttress type legs are suggestive of the ribs of boats with their cargo carved as text vertically along the ribs.
