

# Use of The Square for Political Canvassing on Saturdays

*Approved at Full Council meeting on >*



Eynsham Parish Council supports political openness and invites lawful candidates to make use of The Square in the middle of the village free of charge on each Saturday between the last day on which notice of the election may be published\* and the day preceding the date of election

It would be appreciated if:

1. For management purposes, the candidates would give prior notice to the Parish Clerk of their intention (contact details below).
2. The candidate's pitch would not exceed 3m x 3m.

Regardless of whether notice has been given and on each day of the week any candidate using The Square will be personally responsible and must:

3. Respect the space booked or used by any other candidate or Square user.
4. Not place any signs/banners/materials on the Bartholomew Room building, street furniture or railings in The Square
5. Comply with all legislation regarding elections, equality and discrimination against nationality, race, religion and gender.
6. Not create a nuisance, breach of the peace or obstruction to any traffic, local businesses or residents.
7. Be responsible for and make good any damage caused.

This invitation does not preclude any rights any candidate may otherwise have under law.
