





Green Wheel

20 mph Update



Update

- Working Group formed to consolidate previous speed reduction work – July 21.
- In addition to a village wide 20mph, B roads frequently used by pedestrians and cyclists were included. Much of our usable green space is / will be across B roads.
- Proposal submitted to OCC – February.
- Consultation completed – end of March.



- Recommended for OCC Highway Management Approval – this Thursday
- Implementation dependant on OCC but we hope within 2022
- Included are Gateways at Witney, Hanborough and Oxford
Road signalling to drivers they are entering a residential area where people live, work and shop.
- Enforcement of current limits and proposed limits are a concern to residents.



- A Community Speed Watch (CSW) Group has been established, volunteers trained, monitoring sites and identified.
- CSW groups from neighbouring villages offered helped to get the Eynsham group established.
- If implemented data collected from the CSW will play a part in monitoring the effect of the speed reduction changes.
- After a 12-month period, if necessary, additional traffic calming will be considered the roads that we know are prone to excessive speeds.
- In the coming year street parking enforcement will shift from a WODC responsibility to an OCC.






Neighbourhood Plan Update

- Next step is to start drafting the new policies and amending / toughening up the existing





Strategic Developments Update



Update

- Great joined up approach across the community
- West Eynsham – Masterplan approved – now await detailed planning applications – build out 2 to 5 years?
- Salt Cross Garden Village – Phasing plan now submitted by WODC – awaiting inspector's response – build out 2026 – 2039!!
- A40 – planning approval underway
- OCC – Gravel extraction to east of village – one to watch!
