- My display uses dried flowers because they last longer than fresh ones. It symbolises the longevity of the Queen.
- There are seven colours used across the display, one for each of the decades Her Royal Highness has reigned for (so far!).
- The flowers are surrounded by the seedpods of a Sheppard's purse (an edible plant) which represent the 'thousand hearts' of our community who feel affection for the Queen.
- All the flowers and the Sheppard's purse were sourced locally.
