Eynsham Footpath No 206/30 (Part)
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2017

The above Order was made on the 12 October 2017. The effect of the order as confirmed is **TO DIVERT** the entire width of that part of the public footpath No. 206/30 running from OS Grid Ref SP 44282 20888 (Point A) in a southerly direction for approximately 36m to SP 44282 20885 (Point B) then in a westerly direction for approximately 102m to SP 44272 20885 (Point C) continuing in a southerly direction for approximately 13m to SP 44272 20884 (Point D) then in a westerly direction for approximately 24m to SP 44266 20883 (Point E) further westerly for approximately 162m to SP 44250 20883 (Point F) and further for approximately 52m to SP 44245 20883 (Point G) as shown between Points A – B – C - D - E – F – G on the Order plan **AND CREATE** the alternative footpath running from OS Grid Ref SP 44282 20888 (Point A) in a general westerly direction for 2m then north, north-westerly direction for approximately 31m to SP 44280 20891 (Point H) continuing in a general north-westerly direction for approximately 127m through SP 44270 20898 (Point I) to SP 44269 20898 (Point J) then in a general westerly direction for approximately 42m to SP 44265 20897 (Point K) continuing for approximately 67m to SP 44258 20897 (Point L) then in a general south-westerly direction for approximately 33m to 44256 20857 (Point M) continuing for approximately 60m to SP 44252 20891 (Point N) and further in a general south-westerly direction for approximately 102m to SP 42449 08831 (Point G) re-joining the footpath numbered 206/30 on the Definitive Map for the Parish of Eynsham shown on the Order Plan by a bold dashed line between points A - H – I - J – K - L – M – N - G

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if so made are withdrawn, West Oxfordshire District Council may itself confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
