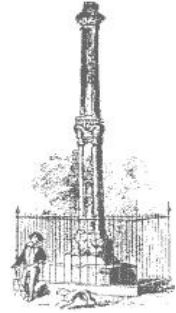

The state of the footpath around the culvert to be included in the report being put together by footpath group for work. Several councillors have walked footpath with little difficulty however brambles need cutting back – Mr. Beach to arrange with contractors once willows inspected. It was agreed in order to bring all the matters under discussion re the allotments together representative of the allotments society would be invited by Mr. Beach to the next parish council meeting to discuss – Mrs. Hughes will bring relevant maps etc and mark all the available entrances to the allotments on these in order to clarify footpaths etc under discussion.
