MINUTES

13/30 Apologies for absence were received from Councillor Mrs Hughes, Councillor Mosson, Councillor Relph, Councillor Rossiter & Councillor Wilding.

13/31 Declarations of Interest – None.

13/32 The Minutes of the meetings held on 4 June 2013– It was **RESOLVED** that the minutes be signed as a true record.

13/33 Public Participation –

- Councillor Mathew said that it was very likely there would be fundamental changes in the funding and delivery of services by Oxfordshire County Council. Already being considered is transport to schools.
- The Council agreed to contact Natalie Blaken, West Oxfordshire District Council, with copies to Barry Norton, West Oxfordshire District Council and Ian Hudspeth, Peter Clark and Martin Tugwell at Oxfordshire County Council, to urge them to expedite matters concerning the damaged wall on Conduit Lane. If this matter has not been resolved within two weeks the Parish Council will contact the press.

13/34 Placing of Dog Bins – Councillor Ms Lawson had previously circulated her report.

- It was **RESOLVED** to move the dog bin from Pinkhill Lane onto Oxford Road playing field and to move from Old Witney Road (near Evenlode) onto Pug Lane. It was further agreed to look for locations for the other lesser used bins situated at the entrance to Oxford Road Play Area and one of the bins in Conduit Lane. The problem of dog fouling was also discussed.
- It was agreed to consider placing a litter bin between the two benches in Oxford Road South towards Fishponds.

13/35 Clerk's Report – The Report was received and considered.

- Oxfordshire County Councillor Mathew has £10k available in the Community Fund for community projects.
- A resident had cut her leg today on a protruding bolt from the rear of a bench in Dovehouse Come & Play. The ground staff have been asked to rectify the problem.
- It was agreed that the police could place a notice board in the corridor of the Village Hall.
