15/97 Apologies for absence received from Councillor Hughes and District Councillor Edward James

15/98 Declarations of Interest – none

15/99 Minutes of the meetings held on 2 December 2014 – It was **RESOLVED** that the minutes be signed as a true record.

15/100 The Council RESOLVED to co-opt Sue Johnson to the Council.

15/101 The Council confirmed Councillor Baldwin as a member of the Planning Committee.

15/102 Public Participation –

- County Councillor Charles Mathew said that the Local Transport Plan 4 (LTP4) is a current priority for OCC. He acknowledges and is arguing for solutions to the problems on the A40, at the Toll Bridge and at Newbridge.
- Councillor Wilding asked about the money being received as part of the Local Enterprise Partnership. Councillor Mathew reported that £35 million was being allocated to look into the problems on the A40.
- Councillor Mathew reported that the public consultation has opened regarding the proposed zebra crossing at Bartholomew School.
- Councillor Rossiter reported that he had been approached by members of the public regarding the state of the road surface at Acre End Street. It was suggested that residents should go on the Oxfordshire County Council Fix My Street website to report their concerns.
- Councillor Andrews was concerned that the footpath and road on Mill Street near the new development needs to be made good when the work is completed.

15/103 The Clerk's Report was received and discussed.

- The Council **RESOLVED** to agree the installation of solar panels at the Pavilion. The Clerk to liaise with Councillor Stukenbroeker regarding the details including insurance cover.
- The Council discussed the consultation regarding the proposed Zebra crossing outside Bartholomew School. It was **RESOLVED** that a representative from Oxfordshire County Council be asked to attend the meeting to give more details regarding the plans.

15/104 Finance - It was **RESOLVED** to pay the accounts as presented. The income & expenditure reports were noted.

15/105 Update on the Council's response to Planning Applications following the Planning meeting. Councillor Stukenbroeker updated the Council on the current planning applications.
