15/223 Declarations of Interest – None

15/224 Minutes of the meetings held on 4 August 2015 – It was **RESOLVED** that the minutes be signed as a true record.

15/225 Public Participation. Councillor Mathew said that it seemed likely the County Council would be required to make a further £65m savings in the near future.

15/226 Correspondence – none

15/227 The Clerk gave a verbal report.

- The height barrier at Oxford Road playing field to be replaced due to damage – quotes being sought.
- The work to refurbish bus shelters is ongoing with funds supplied through S106 funds.
- The multi play equipment in Witney Road Play Area has been repaired.
- There had been no response from members of the public regarding alternative uses for the public toilet building. Members of the council expressed concern about losing the facility.
- A name for the new development off Spareacre Lane has not yet been agreed.
- The council **RESOLVED** to provide a new dog waste bin – agreed location at the Hawthorn Road end of the bridleway.
