16/455 Declarations of Interest – none.

16/456 Public Participation

County Cllr Mathew said that he spoke vociferously against the Thornbury Road planning application – mainly based on infrastructure problems. He felt that recent applications are coming forward because of the lack of land bank and planning by WODC.

16/457 Mr Andrews had previously circulated to councillors a draft of the Eynsham Neighbourhood Plan for the council to discuss before sending out for pre-submission consultation to statutory consultees. The plan would then be submitted to WODC before being sent out for general consultation.

3200 houses in total – recommendation to build them all to the north on the grounds that the Garden Village will need to be built as quickly as possible. This would confirm the sustainability of the Garden Village whereas building to the west would overload the current services.

600 houses as a reserve site for the future.

16/458 The council discussed their response to the WODC Local Plan.

A number of aspects of the WODC Local Plan changes listed in a previously circulated paper were discussed. The points will be written up and circulated for approval at the Council meeting on Dec 6th.
