MINUTES

Councillors Present – Cllr R Macken (Chairman), Cllr Tricia Crowley, Cllr Sue Osborne and Sophia Vernon (co-opted member).

Also in Attendance – Clerk to the Council. There were two members of the public present.

21/T23 To receive apologies for absence – None.

21/T24 To receive Declarations of Interest in agenda items – None.

21/T25 To receive Sophia Vernon's Acceptance of Office form for the Working Group – Sophia Vernon's Acceptance of Office form was signed.

21/T26 Public Participation - to receive submissions from members of the public – None. Clerk is to liaise with Cllr Crowley on the content of future email responses. Clerk is to liaise with the Communications Officer on how best to communicate the future County Council 20mph scheme consultation with the community.

21/T27 To consider and recommend the co-option of Judy Reid to the Working Group – It was **RECOMMENDED** that Judy Reid is co-opted to the Working Group.

21/T28 To approve the Council's exhibition material for GBGW 25 and 26th September including a list of Frequently Asked Questions – The exhibition material was finalised.

21/T29 To receive an update from Sophia Vernon on behalf of Old Witney Road residents – It was noted that the access road into Old Witney Road has started to be built. Sophia is to speak with Thomas Homes about funding the cost of two vehicle surveys for Old Witney Road in order to support potential traffic calming measures. It was **RECOMMENDED** that the Council order the vehicle surveys when confirmation is received from Thomas Homes that they will donate funds to the Council by way of reimbursement. Cllr Levy is to be asked to contact the Evenlode Pub regarding no through access of its car park.

21/T30 To receive an update on Oxfordshire County Council's (OCC) work and costings – It was agreed that the Clerk ask OCC to reduce the number of 20 repeater signs where known vehicle speeds are already approximately 20mph. The Clerk reported the following estimated costings. Additional costs are to be included for communication requirements £300 and 16 locations for post-implementation vehicle surveys £2400 approx.

21/T31 To review the total project budget thus far for each element of the Traffic Regulation Order – A budget of £10,44 is available in the current financial year. Clerk is to identify grant funding opportunities.

21/T32 To consider future meeting times for the Working Group - 12 October at 6.45pm and 30 November at 7.30pm
