**21/T33 To receive apologies for absence** – None.

**21/T34 To receive Declarations of Interest in agenda items** – None.

**21/T35 To receive Judy Reid's Acceptance of Office form for the Working Group** – The Clerk apologised for the absence of the Acceptance of Office form. Deferred to the next meeting.

**21/T36 Public Participation - to receive submissions from members of the public** – None.

**21/T37 To receive an update from Sophia Vernon on behalf of Old Witney Road residents** – No update was available due to the previous resident's meeting being cancelled with Thomas Homes.

**21/T38 To receive an update on traffic surveys and agree actions** – The Clerk advised that she is awaiting confirmation from Thomas Homes before being able to confirm the surveys with Oxfordshire County Council. The Clerk will pursue Thomas Homes next week for a response.
