MINUTES

Councillors Present – Cllr Ross Macken (Chairman), Cllr Tricia Crowley, Cllr Sue Osborne, Judy Reid (co-opted member) and Sophia Vernon (co-opted member).

Also in Attendance – Clerk to the Council. There were no members of the public present.

21/T42 To receive apologies for absence – None.

21/T43 To receive Declarations of Interest in agenda items – None.

21/T44 To receive Judy Reid's Acceptance of Office form for the Working Group – Judy Reid's Acceptance of Office form was signed and counter-signed by the Clerk. A Register of Interests form has already been completed.

21/T45 Public Participation - to receive submissions from members of the public – None.

21/T46 receive a briefing from Communities, Oxfordshire County Council (OCC) on the proposals to date and receive an update on work – Cllr Crowley referred to OCC's 'Requesting 20mph' [webpage](#) and proposed that the Clerk register for the pilot scheme although proposed scheme is yet to be finalised. Traffic surveys for the 3 locations are being undertaken during the period 10-17 November. OCC will consider the results and decide whether the lower requested limits for the B4449 are acceptable. Thereafter, the final scheme will be agreed at the next Traffic Working Group meeting for resolution by the Full Council on 7 December.

21/T47 To receive an update from Sophia Vernon on behalf of Old Witney Road residents – A meeting is scheduled for 17 November.

21/T48 To receive an update on traffic surveys and agree actions – Discussed at 21/T46.

21/T49 To resolve gateway options and costs – It was noted that Glasdon recycled plastic gateways have a life expectancy of 10-30 years. The 20mph sign must be displayed on both sides of a road at the gateways although the gateway styles are not required to match. Members started to discuss their preferred gateway styles and ran out of time. For future consideration.

21/T50 To consider future meeting times for the Working Group – 30 November at 7.30pm and 14 December at 6.56pm.

The meeting closed at 7.33pm.
