Also in attendance – Clerk to the Council. There were no members of the public present.

**22/T16 To receive apologies for absence** - None.

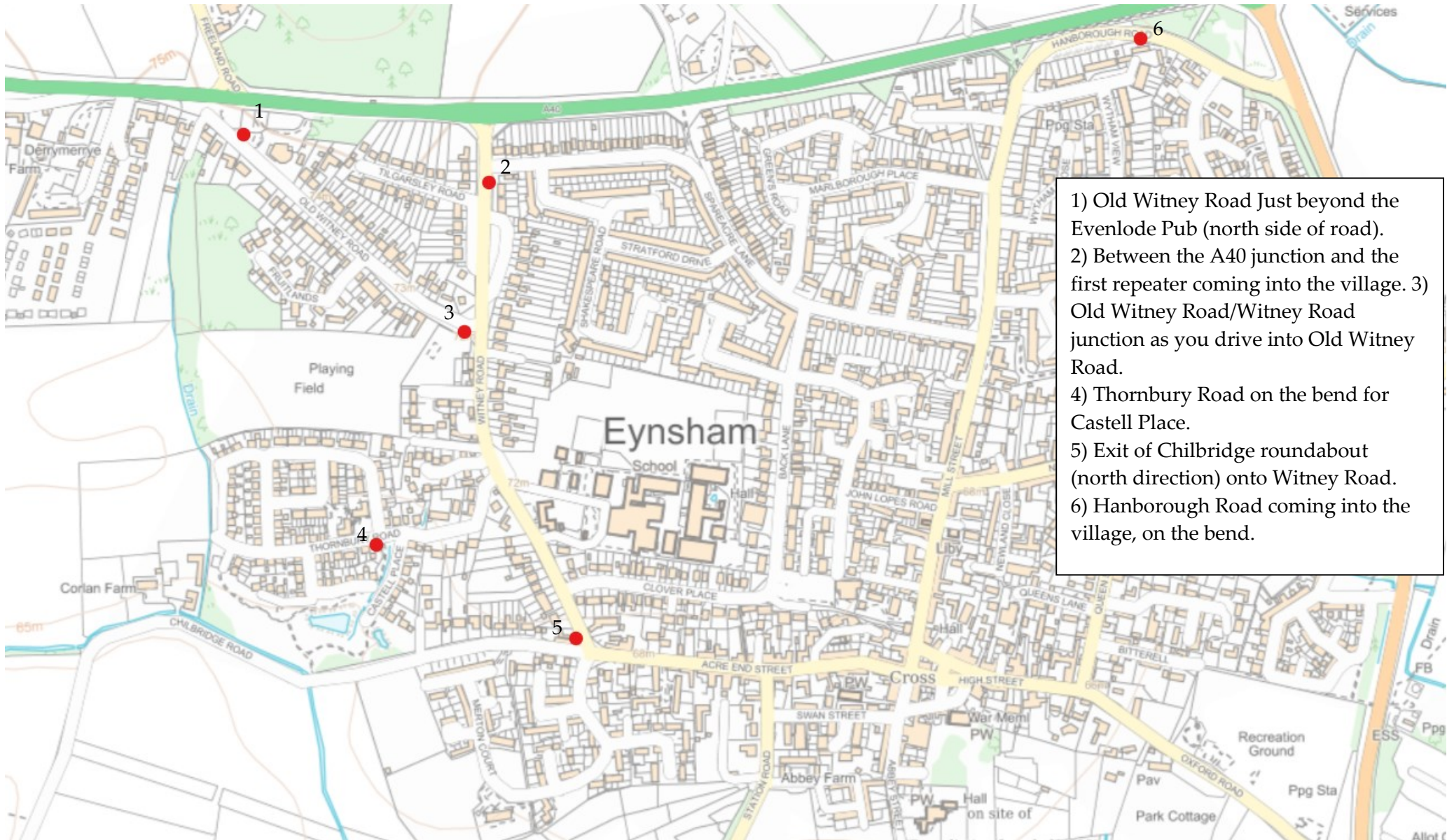
**22/T17 To receive Declarations of Interest in agenda items** - None.

**22/T18 Public Participation** - None.

**22/T19 Speed reduction in and around Eynsham 20mph, 30mph and 40mph.**

- (a) To consider any extra repeater signs required and agree actions – It was **RECOMMENDED** to request extra repeater signs at the locations shown in Appendix A. It was noted that the repeater signs have been installed in accordance with the agreed plan. Clerk is to report on Fixmystreet.com, the trees on the Hanborough Road (north side) need trimming back, away from the road.
- (b) To consider any supporting work with the schools – District Councillor Andy Goodwin and Cllr Milly Chen are to talk with the Primary School about [‘Living Streets’](#) walk to school week in May.
- (c) To receive an update on the Witney Road Vehicle Activated Sign (VAS) project – It was noted that the sign will be part funded from the (County) Councillor Priority Fund. Final details are to be resolved including Oxfordshire County Council’s approval for a solar VAS mounted on streetlight 16 or in that region.
- (d) To consider distribution of 20mph materials (resolution 22/140 refers) and agree actions
  - 2 school banners - Sophia Vernon is to talk with the schools about display locations.
  - 1 ‘20’s plenty’ banner – Location to be agreed in due course.
  - 100 wheelie bin stickers – The Communications Officer is to invite residents to request stickers and supply their addresses (accepting the Council’s Privacy Policy in the process). The stickers will then be distributed by the committee.
- (e) To recommend traffic surveys (tubes) are undertaken in 2023 and include in 2023/24 budget – It was **RECOMMENDED** that traffic surveys are included in next years’ budget, to be undertaken mid-June 2023 (term time). The 9 locations are shown in Appendix B and a budget of £1340 will be required. Old Witney Road will also be surveyed, organised and paid for by Thomas Homes. It was further **RECOMMENDED** that the committee request OCC supply GPS traffic survey data annually which is currently free of charge.

The remaining agenda items were deferred to the next meeting. The meeting closed at 7.30pm.



- 1) Old Witney Road Just beyond the Evenlode Pub (north side of road).
- 2) Between the A40 junction and the first repeater coming into the village. 3) Old Witney Road/Witney Road junction as you drive into Old Witney Road.
- 4) Thornbury Road on the bend for Castell Place.
- 5) Exit of Chilbridge roundabout (north direction) onto Witney Road.
- 6) Hanborough Road coming into the village, on the bend.
