23/T10 Old Witney Road –

- a) To consider traffic calming proposals (funded by developer) following a site visit by Oxfordshire County Council and agree actions – members of the working group debated the proposals. Amendments were made to 6.1, 8.3 and 8.4 on report/proposal document. Sophia Vernon agreed to send document to Clerk regarding closure of Old Witney Road.
