22/AE14 To receive apologies for absence – Cllr Sue Osborne and Cllr Rylett.

22/AE15 To receive Declarations of Interest in agenda items – None.

22/AE16 Public Participation – None.

22/AE17 To receive correspondence and agree actions – None.

22/AE18 To receive update on bridge and steps on footpath 206/2 – 22/AE10– Committee RESOLVED to defer to next meeting to allow Cllr Sue Osborne to update.

22/AE19 To discuss and agree further actions for an off-road route along Mile Straight (B4449 Stanton Harcourt Road), linking to FP 206/4 – Cllr Ross Macken reported to committee that he has spoken with the land owner and had received no further update. It was RESOLVED to attempt to speak with land owner again to obtain permission.

22/AE20 To discuss and agree recommendations for play area improvements – the recommendations were discussed by committee, two further items of consideration were added to recommendation. It was RESOLVED to accept recommendation with two amendments added. Deputy Clerk updated the committee on situation of S106 funds, West Oxfordshire District Council to date have refused to allow S106 allocated for 'recreational use' to be used on playground upgrades. Further communications has been sent to the authority and once response received committee will be updated.
